

Privacy Policy for Sensory, Inc.

Sensory is the sole owner of the information collected on its public websites: specifically www.sensoryinc.com and www.3Dmsg.com. Sensory collects personal information for fulfillment and inquiry purposes only from its websites, and does not engage in e-commerce activities or request personally sensitive information in order to view or use them. Sensory maintains reasonable security precautions regarding access to and storage of data collected from its customers.

Login accounts are limited to employees and partners and are typically covered under mutual disclosure agreements separately from this policy. This policy does not apply to various Sensory partners who may be linked to a Sensory website or to any person or company that Sensory does not own or manage. Sensory uses any information collected from the general viewing public for the following general purposes:

- Sensory automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including but not limited to your IP address, referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamps, and the pages you are requesting. This data is used to streamline how the website is utilized and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole.
- Sensory maintains contact information provided from website forms, traditional mail and/or by email for product inquiries, demo requests or registration purposes. This information is primarily used to respond to customer requests for information and to inform customers of potential issues or upgrades for Sensory related products, and may be used for Sensory promotional purposes. This information is only accessible to Sensory employees or Sensory authorized international sales representatives.

Sensory as a business does not rent, share or sell personal information collected from its websites with non-affiliated companies except for the following reasons:

- We reserve the right to disclose your personally identifiable information as required by law and when we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on our Web site
